

Career Cruising Learning Styles Inventory

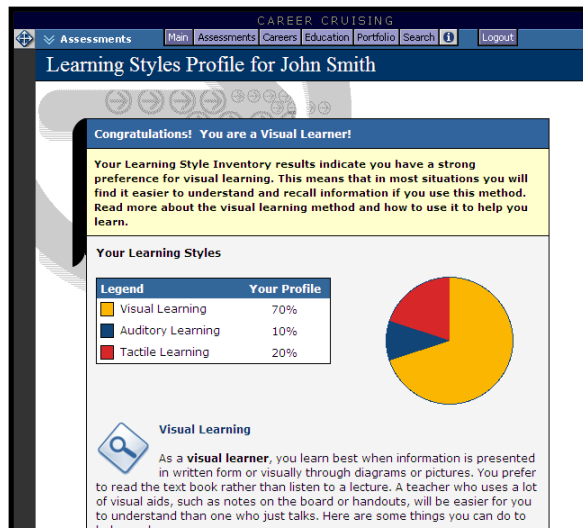
Career Cruising's Learning Styles Inventory is designed to help users understand how they learn and retain information. The assessment consists of 20 questions in which users are asked about their preferences and tendencies. The Learning Style profiles analyze the responses according to three learning methods—visual, auditory, and tactile. Users may be identified as having a primary, primary and secondary, dual, or mixed learning style.

Individualized Profiles

The individual Learning Styles Profile displays the distribution of their responses in both chart and graph format. Users receive feedback about what it means to be a visual, auditory, or tactile learner, including tips and techniques for studying and learning new information.

Accessing Learning Styles

To access the Learning Styles Inventory, click on the Assessments button in the purple menu bar at the top of the page and then select "Learning Styles Inventory". Students taking the assessment for the first time will be asked to enter their name. This ensures that if users are printing their profiles, they will be sure they have picked up their own results and not someone else's. Users can save their results to their portfolio and retrieve their profile at any time.



Learning Styles Reports

Administrators have access to two new reports in the Portfolio Reports section of the Career Advisor Management System (CAMS):

- Learning Styles Distribution shows aggregate data on how many students have been identified within each learning style.
- Learning Styles by Student lists the students who have taken the assessment, with their identified learning style and a link to their profile.
